EVENT DESCRIPTION

The event will be round 3 of the 2009 VICTORIAN HILLCLIMB CHAMPIONSHIP, to be conducted at the Mt Leura Lookout Road, Camperdown, in (Sat/Sun) 21st and 22nd March 2009.

ENTRIES

ENTRIES OPEN Monday 2nd March 2009 AND CLOSE ON WEDNESDAY 18th March 2009.

THE ENTRY FEE IS \$88.00 (includes GST). CHEQUES AND MONEY ORDERS SHOULD BE MADE PAYABLE TO THE BALLARAT LIGHT CAR CLUB.

Entry forms should be completed in full, accompanied fee and lodged with the Meeting Secretary **prior to the closing date**. A refund of the entry fee may be allowed for entries withdrawn at least one week prior to the event by notifying the Meeting Secretary .

Entries withdrawn after this date will not receive a refund.

The event will be limited to 90 (ninety) starters. The Promoter will reserves the right to refuse entry without assigning any reason therefore - see NCR 83. If more than the maximum field of entries are received the Promoter will select entries as the see fit.

COMPETITION

- OPTIONAL PRACTICE will commence at 1.30pm and conclude at 4.30pm on Saturday 21st March 2009.
- THERE WILL BE NO PRACTICE ON SUNDAY 22nd March 2009 .
- Each competitor will have a minimum of **FOUR OFFICIAL TIMED RUNS** .

PERSONS ELIGIBLE

The event shall be open to members of clubs affiliated with CAMS who are holders of a current CAMS level 2S or superior licence.

SCRUTINY

A. Optional Practice Day - On Sat March 21st .Scrutiny will commence at 1.30pm and conclude at 4.30pm

B. Competition Day - On Sun March 22nd - scrutiny will commence at 8.00am in the Cattle Pavilion if needed and conclude at 9.00am

All vehicles must be scrutineered and passed for practice and competition prior to participation. CAMS

Licences, Competition Records and current Club Membership Cards must be produced at scrutiny.

ALL VEHICLES COMPETING IN THE 2009 VICTORIAN HILLCLIMB CHAMPIONSHIP MUST HAVE A CAMS LOG BOOK which must be presented at Scrutiny.

Entries will be accepted from competitors/vehicles without a CAMS log Book, but these entries will only be accepted after all Log Booked entries have been accepted. Such competitors will not score points in the 2009 Victorian Hillclimb Championship.

DRIVERS BRIEFINGS

THE ATTENDANCE OF ALL DRIVERS IS COMPULSORY AT THE DRIVERS BRIEFINGS.

Competitors on Sunday will be required to attend the drivers briefing to be held at 9.15am on Sunday 22nd March. Drivers will be required to sign an attendance sheet. The starting order will be advised at the Drivers Briefing.

INSURANCE

Competitors are covered by Personal Accident Insurances provided by the Promoters as is Public Risk in accordance with Appendix 1. parts 1 & 2 of the 2009 NCR.

PROTESTS

Any protests must be lodged in accordance with part XII of the NCR.

ABANDONMENT

The Promoters reserve the right to abandon, postpone or cancel the meeting in accordance with NCR 59.

ANTI DOPING POLICY

During any competition, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate, Refer NCR 145A. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Drugs in

Sport Policy. Competitors, crews and officials may be tested for alcohol or other drugs at any time during the event(s). This regulation serves as the required 24 hour notice to Competitors, Crew and Officials.

SAFETY - DRIVER

Drivers must wear a helmet to a standard listed in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, and be deemed by the scrutineers of the event to be in a suitable condition for motorsport use, non flammable clothing, suitable footwear, and goggles or visors with lens other than glass in open cars (see Section 6, Schedule D of the CAMS Manual).

SAFETY - CARS

The attention of competitors is drawn to Section 6 of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport in which all vehicle requirements are listed in detail. Silencers are not mandatory, but vehicles must not exceed a noise limit of 95dB(A). Vehicles must be fitted with a fire extinguisher complying with Section 6, Schedule H of the CAMS Manual. Competitors are reminded that the possession and use of Halon/BCF fire extinguishers, other than

where specific approval has been given by the E.P.A., is prohibited. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the CAMS Manual.

NOISE

All competing cars must be fitted with a device that restricts the exhaust noise level of 95db (A) measured at a distance of 30 meters on a drive by test under full acceleration. Vehicles must be tested during practice and competition on both days. *Any competitor's car that exceeds this limit will be warned. A second offence will result in expulsion from the remainder of the meeting.*

COMPETITION NUMBERS

Competitors who have registered permitted numbers will be given preference. Please advise on the entry form if it is the case.

AWARDS

Trophies will be awarded for first, second and third placing's in each class. In addition, a trophy will be awarded for the Fastest Time of the day and the fastest female competitor. Trophies will be present at the conclusion of the competition.

- W Non Log Booked Cars

Note: Classes may, at the Promoters discretion, be combined where there are less than three entries in a class. Where there are sufficient entries, further classes may be created (e.g., Formula Libre up to 500cc, etc.). Competitors in Historic – Other must provide a Certificate of Description for their vehicle.
