**AUTHORITY** The meeting shall be a Multi Club Hillclimb conducted under the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A., the National Competition Rules (NCR) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Limited (CAMS), Victorian Hillclimb Championship Regulations, Speed Event Standing Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations, and any further regulations or instructions that may be issued.

**THE EVENT** The meeting will be held at Bryant Park, Haunted Hills,, Bill Schulz Drive, Yallourn, on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> & Sunday, 26<sup>th</sup> July, 2009. This event is a round of the 2009 Pentathlon Series.

**ENTRIES** Entries will open on **the publication of these regulations** and will close at 5.30 p.m. on **Wednesday, July 22<sup>nd</sup> 5.30pm, 2009**. Entry fee will be **\$95 (junior drivers \$50)**. CAMS Personal Accident Insurance cover will be provided as per Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual. Cheques and Money Orders should be made payable to the **Victorian Mini Club Inc**. Entry forms must be completed in full, accompanied by the entry fee, and be lodged with the Secretary of the Meeting. The Promoters reserve the right to refuse entries in accordance with NCR83.

The Promoters have arranged Public Risk Insurance to the requirements of Appendix I of the NCR. The Promoters reserve the right to stipulate the number of entries for the Meeting, and select entries in excess of such number at their absolute discretion. **The maximum number of entries shall be 125**, accepted in order of receipt.

**PERSONS ELIGIBLE** The event shall be open to members of invited clubs who are holders of a CAMS Level 2S or higher Licence. The invited Clubs are those listed on the CAMS website as being currently affiliated with CAMS (refer to [www.cams.com.au](http://www.cams.com.au)) .

**SCRUTINY** Scrutiny will commence at 8.00 a.m. and conclude at 12.30 p.m. on Saturday, July 25<sup>th</sup>, 2009 & will commence at 8.00 a.m. and conclude at 9.45 a.m. on Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> July 2009. All cars must be scrutineered and passed for competition prior to the commencement of the meeting. Current Membership Cards, Log Books (if issued), Competition Records and a CAMS Level 2S or higher Licence must be produced at Scrutiny, and on request throughout the meeting.

**DRIVERS BRIEFING** The attendance of all drivers is required at a Drivers Briefing to be held at 12.45 p.m. on Saturday, July 25<sup>th</sup>, 2009, and at 9.30 a.m. on Sunday the 26<sup>th</sup> July 2009. The starting order will be advised at the Drivers briefing. Any changes to the running order during the event are at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.

**COMPETITION Official** competition runs will commence at 1.00 p.m. on Saturday, July 25<sup>th</sup>, 2009. Unofficial untimed practice may be held between 8.00 a.m. and 12.00 p.m. on the morning of the Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> prior to competition. Competition will recommence at 10.00 a.m. on Sunday, July 26<sup>th</sup> 2009. A track familiarisation run maybe held on the Sunday morning prior to competition at the discretion of the Clerk Of course. The number of official runs on each day will be advised by the Clerk of Course at drivers briefing.

**TIMING** The event will be electronically timed, and the fastest time will determine event winners. In the event of a tie, the next fastest official time of each competitor will determine event winners. Timing will be to the hundredth of a second. The Clerk of Course will be the Judge of Fact.

**AWARDS** Trophies will be awarded to the person achieving fastest time of day, and to the persons recording fastest time in each class. Final results will be published on the Victorian Hillclimb Website [www.hillclimbing.com.au](http://www.hillclimbing.com.au)

**PROTESTS** Any protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the NCR.

**ABANDONMENT** The Promoters reserve the right to abandon, postpone or cancel the meeting in accordance with NCR 59.

**ANTIDOPING POLICY** During any competition, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate, Refer NCR 145A. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of Procedure for Alcohol testing and CAMS Drugs in Sport Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be tested for alcohol or other drugs at any time during the event(s). This regulation serves as the required 24-hour notice to Competitors, Crew and Officials.

**SAFETY - DRIVER** Drivers must wear a helmet to a standard listed in the 2009 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, and be deemed by the scrutineers of the event to be in a suitable condition for motorsport use, non flammable clothing, suitable footwear, and goggles or visors with lens other than glass in open cars (see Section 6, Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual).

**SAFETY - CARS** The attention of competitors is drawn to Section 6 of the 2009 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport in which all vehicle requirements are listed in detail. In particular, fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the CAMS Manual and all vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions.

**ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES** **ALL ENTRIES WILL BE DEEMED ACCEPTED FOR THIS MEETING UNLESS THE COMPETITOR IS NOTIFIED TO THE CONTRARY.**
